Retail Analyst

This position reports directly to the CFO and will work closely with the COO and Territory Managers to establish standards and KPI's for the retail network. The primary focus of the Retail Analyst will be to manage inventory, review margins and oversee the P&L for the company-controlled locations. This will be accomplished by reviewing existing programs, exploring new opportunities, and developing strategies to improve operations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the inventory at our company-controlled locations
 - Organize quarterly inventory counts
 - Organize cycle counts
 - Develop standards for shrink
 - Determine optimal inventory levels for sales
 - o Develop robust purchasing and receiving processes
- Responsible for reporting on product margin
 - Develop margin expectations per item, sub-department and department
 - o Compare margins across the network looking for best in class and missed opportunities
 - Analyze shrink and its impact on margins
- Using industry/vendor data, ensure sites have top selling items as part of the merchandising mix
- Working with the Category Manager and Merchandising Manager, use margin and sales data to make decisions on programs, planograms and merchandising mix
- Work with POS support team to ensure appropriate price changes are made in the system
- Prepare a P & L per site for management review
- Prepare forms for annual royalty reconciliation process and review information submitted by franchisees
- Review all fees and commissions and ensure the correct amounts are being applied
- Other duties as required
